NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a petition was filed with the University of New Mexico Labor Management Relations Board ("UNM Labor Board").

PETITIONED-FOR BARGAINING UNITS:

1. Faculty with the following titles: Professor; Professor of Practice; Assistant Professor; Associate Professor; Research Professor; Research Assistant Professor; Research Associate Professor; Lecturer I, II and III; Principle Lecturer I, II and III; Research Lecturer I, II and III; Research Lecturer I, II and III; Senior Instructor; and Instructor employed at the Main Campus in Albuquerque and the branch campuses in Gallup, Taos, Los Alamos and Valencia County, **excluding** Department/Division Chairs, Department Directors, all Visiting Faculty, Working Emeritus and all faculty positions at the Health Sciences Center.
2. Adjunct faculty employed at the Main Campus in Albuquerque and the branch campuses in Gallup, Taos, Los Alamos and Valencia County.

Pursuant to UNM Labor Board Rule 2.9, a **labor organization** may file at any time within ten (10) workdays **after** the date of posting of this INTERVENTION NOTICE a petition as intervenor with the UNM Labor Board.

An intervenor petition **must** be accompanied by a showing of interest showing that at least thirty percent (30%) of the employees in the petitioned-for bargaining unit wish to be represented by the intervenor for purposes of collective bargaining.

This INTERVENTION NOTICE will be posted in places where notices to employees are normally posted and will remain posted continuously for at least five (5) working days.
